Welcome to the Glen Iris Valley Recreation (Tennis) Club and thank you for considering Glen Iris as your future tennis club for you and your family.

The Club has a rich tradition dating back to 1923 when the Club was established at Brixton Rise Glen Iris adjoining Gardiner's Creek. The Club vacated the site in 1987 when it was required for the construction of the now Monash Freeway. The Club re-established itself on its current site on High Street Road Mount Waverley in 1991 with a brand new tennis facility comprising a modern 2-level clubhouse enjoying panoramic views, on-site car-parking and 12 red porous tennis courts, all in a landscaped setting.

The facility is today maintained to the highest standards and is now able to offer all-year tennis with a recently installed reclaimed storm-water reticulation system.

The Club offers a complete tennis experience with social play, organised competition for adults on midweek, night, and weekend, and for juniors on weekends. Coaching is available at all levels from the Club's accredited coaching professionals. Tournaments are held at the Club the most important of which is the Club's UnderAge Tournament held in June/July each year attracting the best juniors in the country. The Club also has an organised social program so there is every opportunity to enjoy fellow members company in an off-court social setting.

The Club has established a new member welcome program so you'll feel part of the Club as soon as you join. Please feel free to inspect the facility at your leisure and to ask any questions that you may have about the Club.

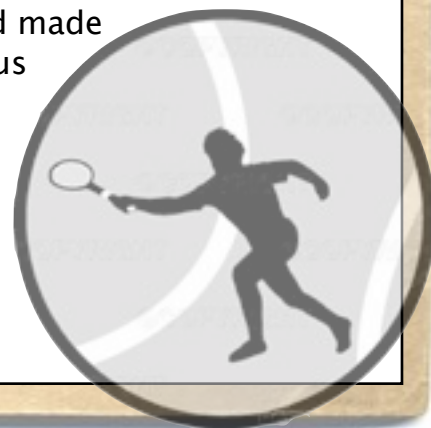

NIGHT TENNIS

The Club presently has six of its twelve courts under lights. Members are welcome to play under lights, by prior arrangement. The cost is \$10 per hour for members and \$20 for non-members.

A popular night tennis option is to join one of the midweek intra-club competitions. These are held each week on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings (listed in decreasing order of strength), starting at 7.30 pm. The tennis format varies between nights, and is dependent on the number of players and the variation in standard between the players. Matches comprise mens, women's and/or mixed doubles formats. Teams usually consist of more than the four players required on any given night, so a rotation is used (which also offers flexibility to members). The year is divided into 3 or 4 seasons with breaks during school holidays. Each season concludes with a party/BBQ or similar social event.

A further option for playing night tennis is in one of the district competitions (e.g. WDTA or BDNTA). It should be noted that the intra-club night tennis competitions take priority. For this reason, it is preferred that teams only be submitted on Monday and possibly Tuesday nights.

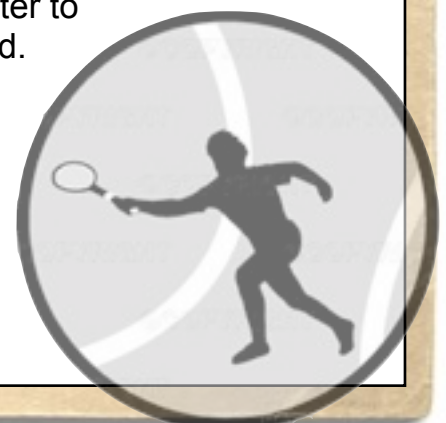
We are engaged in competitive play on Tuesdays and Thursdays throughout the year excluding all school holidays. Matches are played at home and away commencing at 9.30 am and conclude with a light lunch provided by members of the home team. The competition runs

for approximately 14 weeks and culminates in the top four teams playing off for the final 4 places.

The teams are graded to ability by a selection committee which cater to all levels, and wherever possible friendships are always considered. Positions for emergency players are included so sick days or holidays are catered for.

Tennis Victoria - Pennant Competition

In Melbourne the highest level of competition played is Winter Pennant. Glen Iris Valley Recreation Club is steeped in history and we pride ourselves as being one of the strongest tennis clubs in Victoria. We provide a full range of teams, which gives players an incentive to improve, especially the juniors. The Club aims to cater for all standards and provide opportunities to all players.

For many years, Glen Iris was a regular in the top section State Grade. Although we haven't fielded a State Grade team for a number of years, we are working towards entering a team in the premier section in the near future. For the 2010 season, Glen Iris fielded 10 men's and 4 ladies teams, with the highest sections being Grade 2 for both the men's and ladies. In 2011, we plan to build upon our strong base and continue to increase the number of pennant teams at Glen Iris in all levels.

District Competition

Glen Iris currently enter teams in the Waverley and District Tennis Association and Bayside Regional Tennis Association. Both competitions are played on Saturday afternoon and run two seasons each year, summer (October – February) and winter (April to August).

SENIORS & SOCIAL TENNIS

Seniors Tennis (35 years+) is a growing area of tennis participation and Glen Iris Tennis Club is doing its bit to support tennis for those of us who are getting on a bit but are still keen for a good hit of tennis.

We usually have teams in Tennis Victoria Seniors Pennant as well as teams in the Waverley and District Tennis Association.

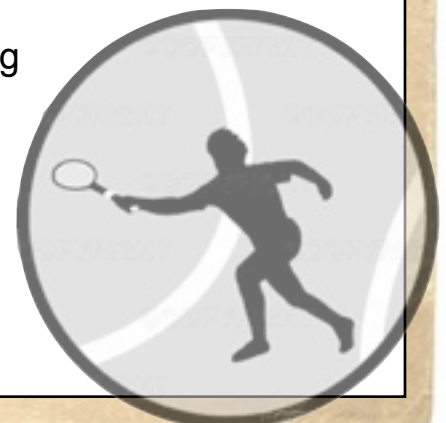

1. Total annual fees quoted are inclusive of GST.
2. The **full** Annual Subscription is payable on admission. Where applicable a pro-rata fee adjustment will be made at 1 January in the year following admission to membership.
3. The Entrance Fee (payable on admission to the Club) has been suspended since 1 January 1998.
4. **Junior membership** is divided into two age groups based on a member's age at 00:00 hours on 1st January each year.
 - (a) Under 15 years
 - (b) 15-17 years inclusive
5. **Full-time tertiary students** 18 years and above will be charged at the Student rate if a **photocopy of the Student's Tertiary ID Card is supplied each year to substantiate eligibility.**
6. Pennant membership runs from 1st April to 31st August and includes the club championships.
7. **Family membership:** A discount of 15% of total annual membership fees applies to a family of **3 or more members** provided that those members are within categories other than Non-Playing and all reside at the same address.
8. The Tennis Victoria player registration fee is paid by the Club on behalf of each member and no reduction in subscriptions will be allowed for any such payments made through another club.
